2. Director's Report:

1. **Holbrook Heritage Room & CPL Board:** Atkin & Rucker met with the City Manager, Jeff Budd Friday, to find out if we can dissolve the CPL Board as discussed at last month's meeting and what needs to be done. The Heritage Holbrook Room would be absorbed into the Branch District library and governed by the BDL Board. The Woodward Trust left no stipulations on how the money was spent other than to take care of the Coldwater Library. We are told the next step is to take talk to our legal council. The Director will have additional information at the next meeting.

- **2. Building Maintenance:** As you know we have been searching for grants to help with the cost of building repair and maintenance. Unfortunately the only grants that are available for libraries stipulate that the building must be owned by the library. The city is willing to give us the building. No decisions have been made, as we are investigating all possibilities.
- **3. Juvenile Code of Conduct:** We have had some behavior problems with our young people that come into the library, hopefully this will take care of those issues.
