Display Case: This month the display case features hand-made fabric pitchers, vases and baskets by staff member Loretta Sherfield. Each one is made by wrapping clothesline with fabric strips and zig-zag stitching.





Mason Jar Candle Holder/Vase: All materials were provided for this fun craft. Burlap strips and lace were decoupaged onto Mason jars and then paper flowers were glued on. This created fun vases for flowers or to hold candles. There were two classes offered on different days to accomodate participants.



Arm Knitting: Who needs knitting needles? Attendees were instructed in the art of "Arm Knitting". Arm knitting utilizes the arms as needles with the addition of super bulky yarn to create an unusual scarf.
