

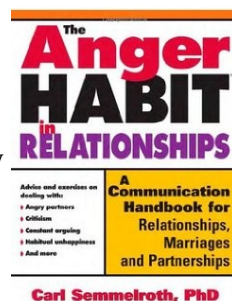
## ADULT PROGRAMMING REPORT January/February 2016
