BRANCH COUNTY — September is National Library Card Sign-Up Month.

Branch District Library is reminding parents, caregivers and students that a library card is a first step towards academic achievement and lifelong learning.

Signing up for a library card can be done in person any of the Branch District Library locations — Algansee, Bronson, Coldwater, Quincy, Sherwood, Union Township — or online at BranchDistrictLibrary.org/ apply.

Those who sign up for a library card in September are entered into a drawing for a \$100 Visa Gift Card.

Not willing to leave out faithful patrons, adults who have a library card may refer a friend needing a library card, and both will be entered into the drawing for a \$100 Visa Gift Card.

Have the friend bring the completed "Refer-a-

Friend" form when they sign up for a library card. Pick up the "Refer-a-Friend" form at any of library location. Multiple entries are allowed.

A library card holder is able to discover new and exciting worlds including borrowing audiobooks, streaming movies and taking virtual classes, said Kimberly Feltner, assistant director of the Branch District Library.

"There is so much you can access," she said. "Pursue your passions and dreams through your library's resources and programs."

Since 1987, Library Card Sign-up Month has been held in September to mark the beginning of the school year. During the month, the American Library Association and libraries unite in a national effort to ensure everyone signs up for their own library card.
