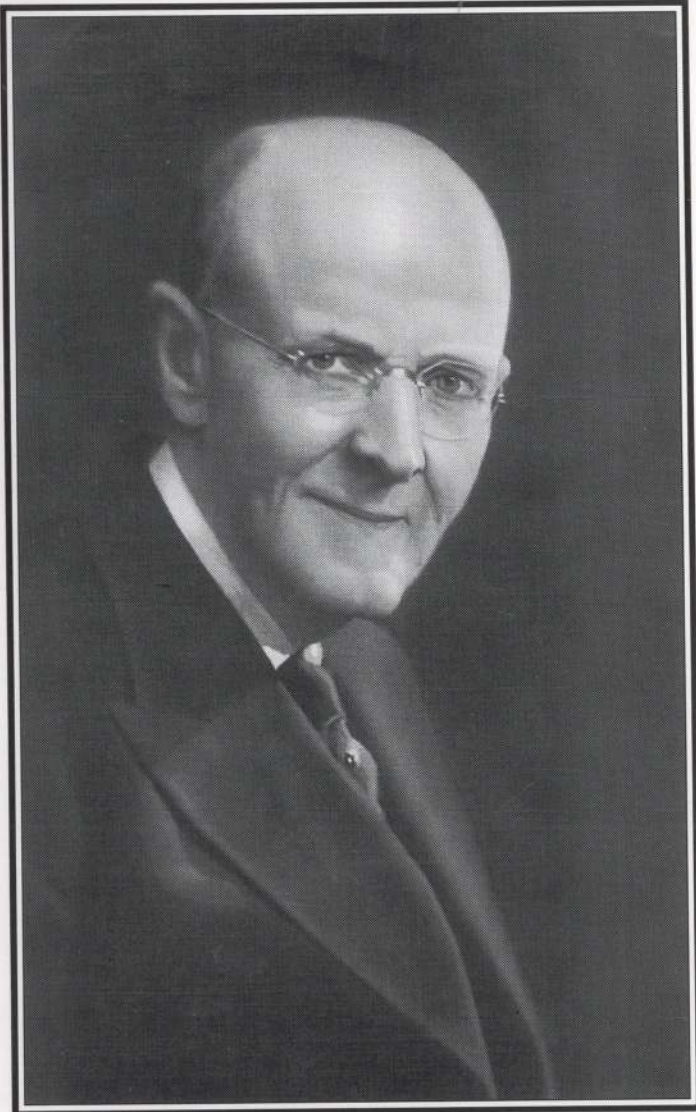

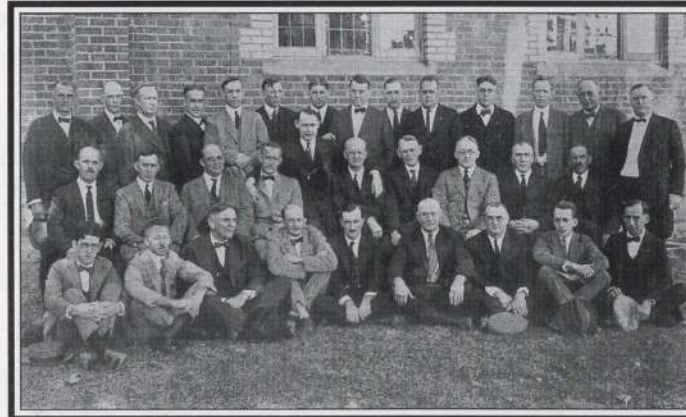

THE DAY IS THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 10; THE PLACE, ARLINGTON HOTEL; THE TIME, 6:30 P.M.

The Organization Committee is greatly pleased with the crew which has been signed up to launch this boat. Listen to the roll call.
