Amendment No. 1

Amend Article VIII, Section 1, by inserting under "B. Citizenship Services" a new subdivision "5. International Relations" and by renumbering each of the succeeding subdivisions, increasing each by one. The section will then read as follows:

Amendment No. 2

Amend Article IX by renumbering Sections 5 to 17 inclusive, increasing each by one, and by inserting a new Section 5 to read as follows:

Section 5. The Committee on International Relations shall recommend methods of implementing objectives relating to the development of friendship between nations and the increase in understanding by residents of one country of the way of life, problems, and aspirations of the people of other nations. It shall recommend the methods by which such purposes may be accomplished and, when these methods have been approved by the Board of Directors, shall seek to carry out such methods and programs.
