

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KIWANIS CLUB OF COLDWATER MICHIGAN

These Articles of Incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1931, known as the Michigan General Corporation Act, as Follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is KIWANIS CLUB OF COLDWATER MICHIGAN.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of purposes of this corporation are as follows:

1. To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
2. To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.
3. To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business, and professional standards.
4. To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive, and serviceable citizenship.
5. To provide through Kiwanis clubs, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service, and to build better communities.
6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.
7. To carry out the foregoing purposes, the corporation shall have power to receive and convey real and personal property and to receive and distribute gifts of property of all kinds.

ARTICLE III

The location of the corporation is the city of Coldwater in the county of Branch, Michigan. Post office address of registered office is 45 East Chicago St., Coldwater, Michigan

ARTICLE IV

Said corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis. The amount of assets which said corporation possesses is: real property---none.

Personal property--Furnishings and cash on hand \$500.00

Said corporation is to be financed under the following general plan: Dues of members will finance the expenses of the club. Special charities may be financed by money raising projects.
