BDL's most checked-out items


W ith over 150,000 checkouts last year, many thousands of items are checked out only a small number of times. These are the highly popular items that stand out in that list. For the third year in a row, *People Magazine* is the most popular item overall, and for the third year, *Diary of a Wimpy Kid* is the most popular kid's book.

Colleen Hoover's Verity was the most popular fiction title, with Hoover's other books taking **6** of the top 10 most popular fiction books at BDL last year.

Digital is clearly the preference for BDL users: downloadable audiobooks were checked out **15** times more than CD audiobooks in 2023!




