POLICY ON SURVEILLANCE OF INTERNET USAGE

Adopted: November 15, 1997

Last Revised: n/a

The Board of the Branch District Library System reaffirms its commitment to the Library Privacy Act (Act 455 of 1982).

In order to assure the security of its Internet System for all, the Board reserves the right to investigate any possible misuse of the Internet Agreement signed by all users of the system, whether staff or public. The automation librarian will monitor usage of the Internet and upon indication of possible misuse, may seek the assistance of law enforcement personnel.

As previously approved by the Board, In accordance with (Michigan Compiled Law) MCL 752.792, MCL 752.793, MCL 752.794, MCL 752.795, MCL 752.796, MCL 752.797 dealing with fraudulent access to computers, computer systems, and computer networks, as amended in ACT 326, effective April 1, 1997, the Branch District Library System may prosecute anyone who violates the above law and may deny that person future access to the Branch District Library System's Internet services at the library and through dial-in access.
