What happens next?



e are thrilled to announce the arrival of our brand new bookmobile! The new bookmobile will serve Branch County as our 7th library branch. Now that it's here, what comes next?

There is a lot of work that needs to happen behind the scenes before the bookmobile is ready to roll and serve. Library staff will need to learn how to drive the large vehicle and how to run its systems while at a stop. More stops throughout the county need to be added to the schedule. Computers and internet access need to be installed. The bookmobile will also have its own collection of library materials, and these need to be purchased, cataloged, and shelved.

With so much to do, we estimate that the bookmobile will not be on the road until Spring 2025. When that time comes, we will host a big ribbon-cutting event!


