BEET

Detroit Dark Red, Medium Top

Round, dark red, 3" roots with tender, sweet flesh are delicious cooked or pickled. Medium sized tops are ideal for greens. Harvest in about 59 days.

SOW in well-worked soil after danger of frost in spring. In frost-free areas, sow in fall. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/2" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 14-21 days.

THIN to stand about 3" apart when seedlings are 1-2" tall.


BUSH BEAN

Triomphe de Farcy

Heirloom French filet bean, bears very early and heavily. Slender, shapely pods have wonderful, distinct flavor. Harvest in about 48 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun after danger of frost, spring to early summer. In rows 18-30" apart, sow seeds about 3" apart and cover with 1" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.

THIN to stand about 6" apart when seedlings are 1-2" tall.

CAULIFLOWER

Snowball Y Improved

Flavorful, 6" pure white heads grow to 3-5 lbs. Good leaf coverage allows for self blanching. Harvest in about 70-80 days.

start indoors in a warm, well-lighted area about 8 weeks before planting outdoors. Sow seeds 1/4" deep into individual containers filled with seed-starting formula. Keep moist. Seedlings emerge in 10-21 days. Before planting the young plants in the garden, plants need to be accustom to outdoor conditions by moving them to a sheltered place outside for a week.

CELERY

Tall Utah 52-70 R Improved

Dark-green stalks and very compact habit. This very productive celery is widely adapted. Resistant to boron deficiency and western celery mosaic. Harvest in about 100 days.

START INDOORS in a warm, well-lighted area 8-10 weeks before last spring frost. In frost-free areas, sow from fall to early spring. Sow seeds 1/4" deep in seed starting formula. Seedlings emerge in 10-21 days. Before transfer to the garden, accustom to outdoor conditions by moving to a sheltered area outside for a week.

SET PLANTS in sunny garden area 6" apart in rows 1 1/2' apart. Stands a light frost.

COLLARDS

Georgia

Tender, blue-green leaves. Will stand light frost, which improves mild cabbage-like flavor. Packet plants 40 ft. of row. Harvest in about 60 days.

SOW in average soil in early spring; midsummer for fall crop. In frost-free areas, sow from fall to early spring. In rows 36" apart, plant seeds evenly and thinly and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly. Plants emerge in 10-21 days.

CUCUMBER

Straight Eight

All-America Selections Winner. A favorite white spine cucumber of the highest quality. Deepgreen color, symmetrically shaped, 8" fruits. Harvest in about 58 days.

SOW in average, well-drained soil in full sun in spring after danger of frost. Sow 4-6 seeds about 3" apart in hills 36" apart. Cover with 1" of fine soil. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.

THIN seedlings to 2-3 per hill when they are 2-3" high.

GARDEN HINTS: To save space and for straight fruits, grow on stakes or trellis netting.

EGGPLANT

Black Beauty

Rich, deep purplish-black fruits can grow to enormous size. Tender and tasty at all stages. At maturity, fruits are broad and blunt at blossom end. Harvest about 73 days after transplanting.

START INDOORS in a warm, well-lighted area 8-10 weeks before last frost. Sow seeds in seed starting formula in individual containers. Sow 1/4" deep, firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 10-21 days. Before transplanting, move to a sheltered area outside for a week.

KALE

Blend

Includes four different kale varieties: 40% 'Dwarf Blue Curled Vates', 20% 'Lacinato', 20% 'Premier' and 20% 'Red Russian'. Packed with 45 different flavonoids, kale is reputed to lower cholesterol, help detoxify the body, counter inflammation, and boost immunity. Harvest in about 60-90 days.

SOW in full sun in early spring; midsummer for fall crop. In Deep South, Gulf and Pacific Coast areas, sow from fall to early spring. Plant seeds evenly and thinly and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly. Plants emerge in 10-21 days. Thin 18" apart.

KALE

Lacinato

An Italian heirloom also called 'Dinosaur' Kale. Blue green strap leaves are heavily crinkled and have an excellent flavor, especially when harvested young and after first frost. Harvest in about 60-80 days.

SOW in full sun in early spring; midsummer for fall crop. In Deep South, Gulf and Pacific Coast areas, sow from fall to early spring. Plant seeds evenly and thinly and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly. Plants emerge in 10-21 days.

THIN 18" apart.

LETTUCE

Black Seeded Simpson

Crisp-textured, loose heads have broad, light green, frilled and crumpled leaves with delicate flavor. Harvest in about 45 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring for first crop, in late summer for fall crop. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days. Sow every two weeks to extend harvests.

LETTUCE

Burpee Bibb

Small, delicious heads, ideal for serving as individual salads. Loosely folded outer leaves of dark-green around a blanched heart of golden yellow. Slow to bolt and resistant to tip burn. Harvest in about 75 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring for first crop, in late summer for fall crop. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days. Sow every two weeks to extend harvests.

LETTUCE

Four Seasons

Small, 6" heads with outer leaves tinged red; inner leaves blanch to creamy yellow. Delicious in salads and sandwiches. Harvest in about 55 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring for first crop, in late summer for fall crop. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days. Sow every two weeks to extend harvests.

Heatwave Blend

Six varieties of lettuce that can take some heat. Includes: 20% 'Lolla Rosa', 20% 'Royal Oak Leaf'; 15% 'Black Seeded Simpson', 15% 'Little Caesar', 15% 'Matchless Butterhead' and 15% 'Salad Bowl'. Harvest in about 45-80 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring for first crop, in late summer for fall crop. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days. Sow every two weeks to extend harvests.

Red Salad Bowl

Maroon-red, deeply cut and finely divided leaves; very attractive in tossed salads with green-leafed varieties. Tender and tasty. Long-standing, slow to bolt. Harvest in about 50 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring for first crop, in late summer for fall crop. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days. Sow every two weeks to extend harvests.

A gourmet blend containing lettuces 15% 'Black Seeded Simpson', 15% 'Red Salad Bowl', 15% 'Lollo Rossa' and 15% 'Royal Oak Leaf', with 20% arugula 'Rocket' and 20% radicchio 'Red Verona'.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring, again in late summer for fall crop. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 10-14 days.

Clemson Spineless

All-America Winner in 1939. 4' high plants produce an abundance of dark-green, slightly grooved, spineless, pointed pods. Best when 2 1/2" long. Harvest in about 56 days.

SOW in average, well-worked soil after all danger of frost. In rows 36" apart, plant 3 or 4 seeds every 12" and cover with 1" of fine soil. Firm lightly. Plants emerge in 14-21 days.

THIN to strongest seedling when plants are 1-2" high.

BUNCHING ONION

Parade

This high-quality hybrid produces nice, straight scallions with extra long, white roots. Firm, mildtasting ends will not form bulbs. Harvest in about 60 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun after danger of frost in spring. In frost-free areas, sow in fall. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.

THIN to stand 3" apart when seedlings are 1-2" high.

ONION

Italian Torpedo

A classic Italian variety that forms bronzy red, 4-6" long by 2-3" diameter bulbs. The mild, pink flesh is great in salads and for pickling. Intermediate day variety. Harvest in about 90-110 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun after danger of frost in spring. In frost-free areas, sow in fall. Sow thinly in rows 12" apart and cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.

THIN to stand 3" apart when seedlings are 1-2" high.

PEA

Sugar Snap

Delicious, fleshy, round pods to eat whole when fully grown or to shell for green peas. Harvest in about 70 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun in early spring for first crop, in late summer for fall crop. Sow seeds 2" apart in double rows spaced 6" apart with 24" between each set of rows. Cover with 1" of fine soil. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.

SWEET PEPPER

Chinese Giant

Large, 4-6", bell-type, dark-green to red fruits grow on 24" tall plants. First introduced by W. Atlee Burpee in 1900. Harvest about 80 days after transplanting.

START INDOORS in a warm, well-lighted area about 8 weeks before planting outdoors. Sow seed 1/4" deep into individual containers filled with seed starting formula. Keep moist. Seedlings emerge in 10-21 days at 75-80°F. Before transplanting, move to a sheltered area outside for a week.

Cherry Belle

All-America Selections Winner. Round, smooth, red radishes with white, crisp, delicious flesh. Proven tops for performance, flavor and wide adaptability. Stores well after harvesting. Harvest in about 22 days.

SOW in well-worked soil after danger of frost in early spring, again in late summer for fall crop. In frost-free areas, sow in the fall. Sow thinly in rows about 6" apart. Cover with 1/2" of fine soil, firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 4-6 days.

THIN to stand about 2" apart.

RADISH

Crimson Giant

Globe-shaped roots have deep crimson skin and reach 1 1/2" in diameter, without becoming hollow or pithy. Solid white flesh is firm, crisp and mild. Harvest in about 29 days.

SOW in well-worked soil after danger of frost in early spring, again in late summer for fall crop. In frost-free areas, sow in the fall. Sow thinly in rows about 6" apart. Cover with 1/2" of fine soil, firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 4-6 days.

THIN to stand about 2" apart.

Double Choice Hybrid

Plants produce tender, smooth, dark-green leaves perfect for both baby spinach and fully mature harvests. Rust-resistant. Harvest in about 35 days.

SOW in average soil in early spring for first crop, again in late summer for fall crop. In the South, sow in fall. Sow thinly in rows 1 1/2-2' apart. Cover with 1/2" of fine soil; firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.

SOW in rich, fertile soil after danger of frost. Sow 1-2 seeds about 36" apart and cover with 1" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 10-14 days. Harvest often and when fruits are small.

WINTER SQUASH

Burpee's Butterbush

Compact plants grow only 4' long, produce butternut shaped fruits averaging 1 1/2 lbs. each. Extra delicious, deep reddish-orange flesh. Harvest in about 75 days.

SOW in rich, fertile soil after danger of frost. Sow 1-2 seeds about 36" apart and cover with 1" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 10-14 days.

SOW in average soil in full sun after danger of frost. Sow seeds about 8" apart and cover with 1" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days. Blooms in summer.

Fourth of July Hybrid

Rich-flavored, 4 oz. fruits ripen extra early on high yielding plants. Indeterminate. Harvest about 49 days after transplanting.

START INDOORS in a warm, well-lighted area 6-8 weeks before planting outdoors. Sow seeds 1/4° deep into individual containers filled with seed starting formula. Keep moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days at 70-75°F. Before transplanting, move to a sheltered area outside for a week.

SET PLANTS 3-4' apart in a sunny location after last frost in spring.

TOMATO

San Marzano

'San Marzano' tomatoes are beloved by Italian cooks for their thick and meaty flesh that is perfect for sauces, canning and drying. Indeterminate. Harvest about 80 days after transplanting.

START INDOORS in a warm, well-lighted area 6-8 weeks before planting outdoors. Sow seeds 1/4" deep into individual containers filled with seed starting formula. Keep moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-10 days at 70-75°F. Before transplanting, move to a sheltered area outside for a week.

SET PLANTS 3-4' apart in a sunny location after last frost in spring.

TURNIP

Purple-Top White Globe

Round roots with bright purplish-red top, pure white base and firm, crisp, mild-flavored flesh. Harvest in about 55 days.

SOW in well-worked soil in full sun in early spring, again in late summer for fall crop. In frost-free areas, sow in fall. Sow thinly in rows 1 1/2-2' apart and cover with 1/2" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 7-14 days.
