Scan For PLANTING GUIDE

Start seeds indoors. Place Catnip seeds in a plastic bag and freeze overnight. Soak the seeds in hot water the next day for 12-24 hours. Plant seeds about 1/8th inch deep and place in a warm dark space. Seeds will germinate in 10-14 days and are ready to be placed in the light. Keep seedlings moist to prevent from drying out. Once plants are 4-5 inches tall they can then be planted in their permanent locations 18-24 inches apart.

Chamomile seeds are best sown directly outdoors but can be sown in flats 4-6 weeks before last frost. Once all danger of frost has passed scatter seeds over loose soil and gently tamp down. Keep area evenly moist. Germination will occur in 10-14 days.

Cliantro is best directly sown in the garden due to the taproot it developes and how quickly it grows. Sow seeds 1/4 inch deep directly in the garden in late spring or early summer. Keep area evenly moist throughout the plants life cylce. Thin seedlings to 8-10 inches apart. Germination should occur in 7 to 10 days.

In cooler zones start seeds indoors 4-8 weeks before last frost. Soak seeds for 8 hours before sowing. Place seeds 1/4 inch deep in biodegradable pots that can be planted directly in the garden. Zones that have at least 4 months of warm weather, sow seed directly outdoors 1-2 weeks after last frost. Soak seeds for 8 hours then sow 1/4 inch deep. Keep area evenly moist until germination occurs in about

Select a sunny spot. Though daisies can grow in Partial Sun, they won't be as big and bright as they will in full sun. Sprinkle seeds on soil and cover them with a light dusting (no more then 1/4 inch) of soil. Keep the soil moist and water carefully as to not wash away the seeds. Deadhead throughout the season to promote further blooming.

Can grow indoors and out. Indoors: Sow seeds on moist seed compost. Place seed tray in a plastic bag until gemination (21 days). Keep compose damp but not wet. Choose a cool spot for seedlings and transfer to 3" pots. Outside: When risk of frost is past, gradually expose seedlings to outdoor conditions for 7-10 days before planting outdoors. Transplant to a sunny, rocky garden after all danger of frost has passed. Space 12-18" apart. Water regularly in well-drained soil.

Scan For PLANTING GUIDE

Starting Indoors: Sow seeds indoors, using covered seedling trays, up to three weeks before the final frost date for optimal germination. Plant seeds 1/4 inch deep, spacing them 1 inch apart for good ventilation. Keep the soil consistently moist by watering your lemongrass two to three times a week during the growing season.

Plant Type: Vining

Start indoors in cooler zones, or direct sow after spring frosts. Choose a spot with full sun. Plant seeds or plants outside when it's above 70°F. Create mounds 2-3' across and plant 4-6 seeds 1" deep atop each mound. Once established thin to 2 of the healthiest sprouts. If soil is dense, add sand into the mounds to increase drainage. Keep area watered and weed free.

In Spring plant mustard green seeds outside about 3 weeks before the last sprint frosts. If you want a Fall harvest, plant the seeds in mid-late Summer. Sow directly into a well tilled and sunny garden. Plant them 1/2" deep, about 6" apart. Water frequently. Harvest when leaves are tender and young. For a stronger, more bitter taste, allow the leaves to grow longer.

To grow Dwarf Pomegranate plants from seeds, start by soaking the seeds in warm water for 24 hours to improve germination. Plant them ½ inch deep in seed-starting mix in a warm area (around 70°F), ensuring the soil remains consistently moist and providing indirect sunlight or grow lights. Transplant seedlings when they are a few inches tall, using a well-draining pot for indoor cultivation, and ensuring they receive bright, direct light for several hours daily. For outdoor planting, start seeds indoors 6-8 weeks before the last frost date and transplant them to a sunny, well-draining location in spring. Regular watering, balanced fertilization, and pruning are essential for both indoor and outdoor growth.

Plant Type: Leafstalk Vegetable

Rhubarb is a perennial that can live up to 10-15+ years in cooler zones. Plant in full sun, but in warmer climates afternoon shade is advisable. Soak seeds for 2+ hrs before planting, cover seed 1/4" deep and water evenly. Thin plants to to 24" apart and split roots every 3-4 years when plants are dormant. Harvest stalks when they are 12-18" long but do not ingest the leaves. Rhubarb leaves are poisonous! Don't harvest stalks during the first growing season so your plants can become established.



Plant Type: Compact Bush

To ensure successful germination, begin by giving the seeds a cold treatment. Place the seeds in a clear plastic bag with moist soil or on a paper towel and refrigerate for 2-3 weeks. After this cold treatment, sow the seeds indoors in well-drained soil, keeping it warm at 65-75°F (18-24°C) for 14-30 days. Once the seedlings are ready, transplant them outdoors after the last frost date, providing sufficient spacing of 12 inches (30 cm) between plants. Boost their growth by mulching with straw to suppress weeds and retain moisture. For strong root development, consider removing the flowers during the first month or two after transplanting.
