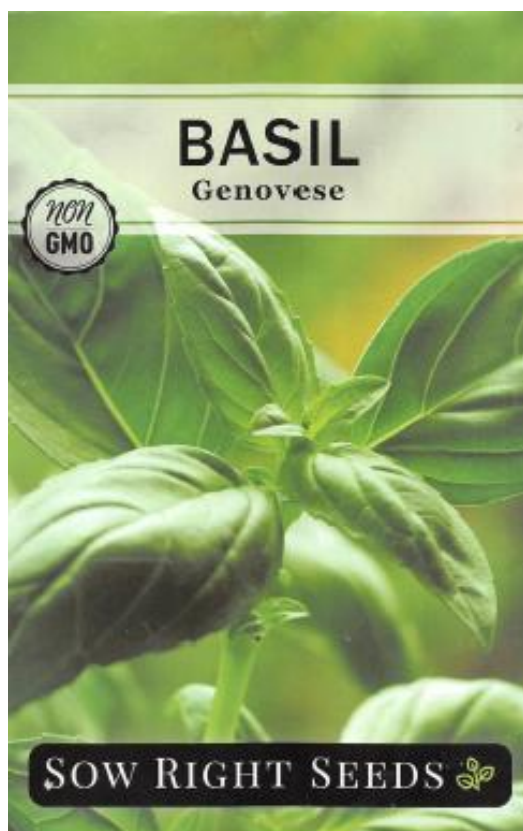

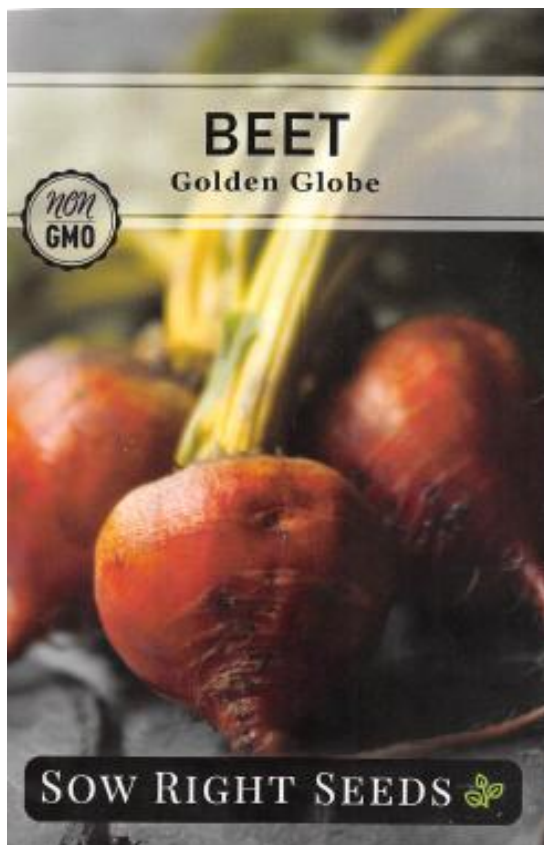

Succession plantings may be necessary to have fresh basil all growing season.
