Plant Spacing

Growing Instructions: May be grown indoors or outside but must have plenty of light. If growing outdoors, start seed indoors and transplant outside after all danger of frost is passed. Begin taking small harvests when the plant has 6 to 8 pairs of leaves. Harvest early and pinch off flower buds to encourage growth and extend harvest. Succession plantings may be necessary to have fresh basil all growing season.

Growing Instructions: In spring or fall, sow seeds outside in loose fertile soil. Keeping seeds moist at all times is key for good germination. After sowing seeds cover the area with garden fabric that allows water to penetrate and water frequently. Remove fabric as soon as sprouts appear. Plant every 3 weeks for continuous harvest.



Growing Instructions: Best started indoors 4 to 6 weeks before last frost date in spring, or 12 weeks before first fall frost. Take care not to disturb roots when transplanting. Babying your cauliflower will

Harvest beans in the shelling stage, i.e. pods change color and beans swell up, or wait until after the beans have dried completely.

















TOMATO



When first true leaves emerge, transplant the seedling into a larger container, burying the seedling deeply to encourage strong roots. Harden off plants and transplant outdoors into fertile, well-drained soil.




