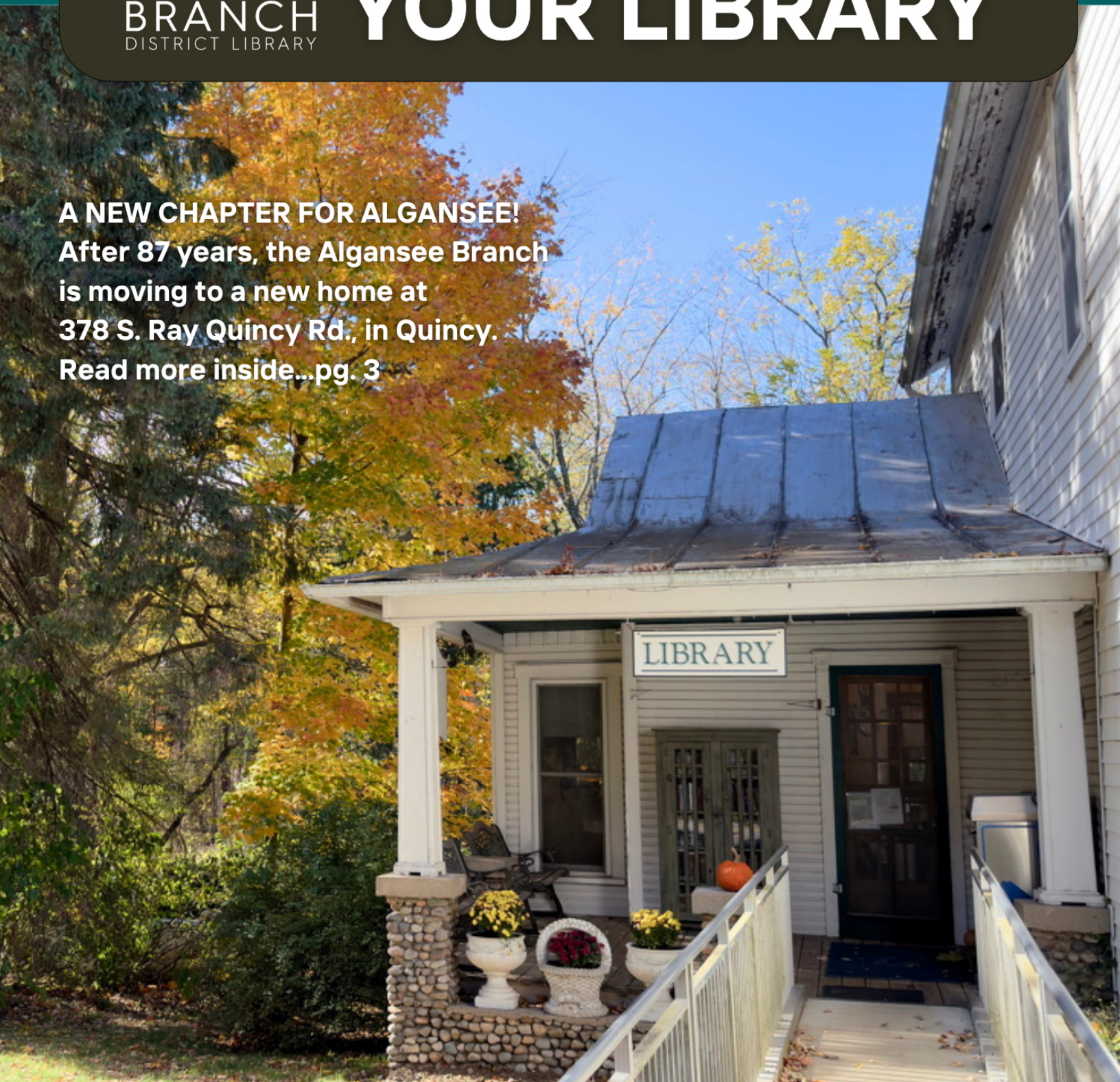

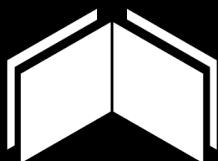

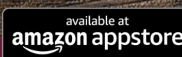

Safford's General Store



Algansee township was established in 1848, with the village of Algansee in the approximate center of the township. A general store in Algansee village known as Safford's Store (built in 1880) was chosen as the place to have the first library, and thanks to a Kellogg Foundation grant, the library opened in 1938, with Doris Williams (née Dove) as the first librarian.

In 1963, the county decided to replace the library with a traveling bookmobile that visited twice a month. It didn't take long to realize that wasn't quite the same as having a real library nearby! So on February 11, 1964, the Branch County Library Board voted to reopen the Algansee Branch, right back where it started.

The library in Algansee has been open ever since, even shifting from one side of the store to the other to make more room for library services.

Although it is a smaller branch in the Branch District Library system, it is mighty! It plays a central role in the community and has seen its usage increase over the last few years. The Algansee Library offers books, magazines, movies, computers with Internet access, and programming for children, teens, and adults.

The new space will have modern heating, air conditioning, and restrooms. There will be more shelves for books and space for programming and meetings. We'll always remember our original location at the Safford Store with fondness, but we're excited to start a new chapter in our beautiful new location!
